What do we learn from this passage?

2. What aspects of your "old way of life" has God begun to transform in you?
3. Do you think the transformation God brings about is only external, or is it also internal? Why?

How do we live this out?

1. Is there anything from your "old life" that you still need to surrender completely to God?
2. What new habit, thought, or attitude do you want to begin cultivating as a **new creation in Christ**?
3. What practical step can you take today to walk in the **new life God has given you**?

Being a new creation means experiencing the flow of God's life in our spirit, and from there, God begins a continuous transformation in our soul toward a new life in Christ, which is ultimately expressed in our body.
