RESTORED OUR RELATIONSHIP

LESSON:

Jesus came to restore our relationship with the Father, to reconcile us to Himself, and to forgive all our sins. Sin originally separated us from God, starting with the fall of Adam and Eve, which broke the perfect relationship between humanity and God. But Jesus' death on the cross made a way for us to be reconciled to God. In John 14:6, Jesus explains that He is the only way to the Father, bridging the gap created by sin and inviting us into a restored relationship with God.

Jesus didn't just come to restore our relationship with the Father, but He also desires a personal relationship with each of us. Jesus knocks on the door of our hearts, inviting us into fellowship with Him (Revelation 3:20). Through His death, He reconciled us to God, making us holy and blameless before Him (Colossians 1:19-22). This relationship brings total forgiveness for all our sins. In Ephesians 1:7, we are told that through Jesus' blood, we receive forgiveness and redemption. Jesus' sacrifice on the cross wipes away all our sins, freeing us from guilt and making us holy in God's sight. In response to Jesus' sacrifice, we must repent and believe in Him to experience this restored relationship with the Father (Mark 1:15). Our lives should reflect this change, living close to God and sharing His forgiveness with others. Jesus came to offer us the gift of a personal relationship with the Father, freedom from sin, and the call to live a life that reflects His love and mercy. Now, it's up to us to embrace this gift with faith and to share the good news of reconciliation with others. Today, let's come together as one big family to watch "The King of Kings" movie. It's a wonderful way to revisit the story of Jesus and remind ourselves of all He has done for us. It also helps us reflect on how much He desires a personal relationship with each of us.
